Discussion Questions

- Share about a time that you were invited into ministry at a young age. What are some of the common themes, methods, or characteristics throughout the different stories that were shared?
 - Do you have the younger generation in your church/ministry? In your personal discipleship and leadership, how can you reach out to and invest in the next generation?
 - .What are some concerns you have about inviting someone from the next generation into your ministry/church? If you are 40 and under, what concerns have you heard expressed by your age group about working in ministry?
 - Do you have a person in your life who is younger than you that you are actively discipling? What does this practically look like? Additionally, do you have someone older than you that is actively discipling you and what does this look like?
 - What roadblocks do you see to different generations working together in ministry?
 - What are some ways that you have or that could work in making a space at the table for different generations?
 - How do we deal with differing mindsets between different generations on issues such as work ethic, conflict resolution, how to run church/ministry, etc. Where have you seen these issues pop up in the past and how were they handled?
 - Do you have a plan in place to raise someone up to eventually take over what you are doing? Additionally, are you raising people up to step into another ministry role or to send them out into the mission field? Would people around you say that they feel believed in and released in ministry?
 - If all titles were stripped away, what is the one thing that God asked you to do that you would need to be obedient to in order to follow his call on your life?
 - What is a practical step you can take in your church/ministry to make room for the next generation outside of what you are already doing?
